Earlene Moore of Lubbock , TX has had the “privilege of playing and working with the sugar arts” for the past 40 years. She opened up her own cake shop in 1975 and sold custom cakes for over 30 years.

She has taken classes under the instruction of some of the most respected sugar artists in the world, and is widely considered one of the best in the business in her own right. She says “I would encourage you to avail yourself of any opportunity to learn from teachers who might come into your area. Learn all you can as the opportunities arise. Every opportunity is unique and each class will give you more options in creating your sugar art.” Although she is one of the most sought after instructors in the US , she still tries to take at least one class from someone else each year in order to keep up with the newest techniques.

Earlene is a charter member of ICES from inception in 1977, was a 6 year member of the Board of Directors, and past President. In 2004 she received the Wilbur Brand award for outstanding service to the ICES organization, and in 2009 she was inducted into the most prestigious ICES Hall of Fame. Earlene has had articles and photographs published in numerous international sugar art, bridal, women’s, and fashion publications over the last 30 years. Ribbons, plaques and awards have been numerous at cake shows. But Earlene feels that the ribbons and awards are not what is important. “The important thing about cake shows and ‘Days of Sharing’ are the people you meet (for networking) and the information you learn, as well as share. We all have learned from other people. No matter the skill level - from beginner to the masters - we all have something we can share with others.”

After many years designing custom cakes Earlene has phased out that part of her business and has been concentrating on a sugar art product line, and teaching sugar art to others in an environment dedicated to caring and sharing.
